	Sensitive data which includes but it is not limited to health data, sexuality, ethnicity and religion are recognised by ICO guidance as "special categories" of data only collected if absolutely necessary. Where this information is collected for monitoring purposes, it is done so on a separate form and the individual cannot be identified.

Who has access to your information?	We will not sell or rent your information to third parties.
	We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes.

Lawful Processing	The GDPR requires us to rely on one or more lawful grounds to process your personal information. The following are the grounds we use are consent, legitimate interest, contract, vital interests
Fundraising and Marketing	CreateBolton is subject to certain rules and privacy laws when marketing to our clients/customers.
	For example, an individual's prior consent is required for electronic direct marketing (for example, by email, text or automated calls). The limited exception for existing customers known as 'soft opt in' allows organisations to send marketing texts or emails if they have obtained contact details in the course of a sale to that person, they are marketing similar products or services, and they gave the person an opportunity to opt out of marketing when first collecting the details and in every subsequent message.
	The right to object to direct marketing must be explicitly offered to the individual in an intelligible manner so that it is clearly distinguishable from other information.
